People with disability are people first and should be seen and treated as people and not as problems

All people with disability have a right to live their life with dignity

All people with disability have a right to be safe

All people with disability have a right to make choices and decisions regarding their own life

All people with disability have a right to participate equally and purposefully in activities and events in their families and in their communities

All people with disability have a right to vote

All people with disability have a right to information about their care, their resources, the plan for their future, their difficulties and their communities

All people with disability have a right to be able to access health, education and recreational opportunities in their community

All people with disability have a right to work and make a living

All people with disability have a right to own assets and inherit property

All people with disability have a right not to be abuse, exploited or maltreated

All people with disability have a right to be treated equal before and seek legal redress if any of these rights are violated
